

The Jewell City Council met in a Regular Session May 24, 2021, at the Jewell City Hall starting at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Reiter called the meeting to order with Council Members: Outzen, Roethler Lorenzen, Winborn and Young present. Absent – none.

APPROVE MINUTES OF MAY 11, 2021, REGULAR SESSION:

Winborn made a motion to approve the minutes of May 11, 2021, Regular Session. Outzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.

CONSENT AGENDA: a) Addition to agenda, b) Claims

With no addition to the consent agenda, Winborn made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.

JEWELL JUBLIEE: *Winborn made a motion to approve the fireworks permit for the June 11, 2021, Jewell Jubilee event. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.*

FERGUSON WATER WORKS: *Utility Billing Clerk Mellissa Roethler presented the City Council information on future software and reader updates. No action was taken.*

HEADWATERS OF THE SOUTH SKUNK WATERSHED MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY:

Young made a motion to appoint Councilmember Roethler as the City of Jewell's representative to the Headwaters of the South Skunk Watershed Management Authority Board and Mayor Leo Reiter as an alternate representative. Winborn seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0, with Roethler abstaining. Motion carried.

JEWELLSWORTH TRAIL:

a. Brian Lammers was present to discuss the upcoming trail project to construct two observations decks on JewEllsworth Trail during fiscal year 2023. He will be asking the City of Jewell to contribute \$6,000.00 to the project. No action was taken.

b. Winborn made a motion to approve \$300.00 to fix trip hazards on the trail. Lorenzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.

2020-2021 BUDGET AMENDMENT:

a. At 7:30 pm, Outzen made a motion to open the public hearing. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried. With no questions or comments, at 7:35pm, Winborn made a motion to close the public hearing. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.

b. Outzen made a motion to approve Resolution 21-11, amending the current budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.

MAIN STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT: *Mayor Reiter reviewed the preliminary design plan options and cost estimates with the City Council. Representatives from Snyder and Associates will attend the next city council meeting to answer questions. No action was taken.*

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN: *The City Council reviewed preliminary information regarding the program guidelines. No action was taken.*

IOWA DOT 5 YEAR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF PRIMARY ROADS

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 290, AMENDING CHAPTER 70 PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC CODE ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES: Winborn made a motion to approve the second reading of Ordinance 290. Outzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0. Motion carried

FRAYS / 600 MAIN STREET: Re-inspection by the State Fire Marshall has been scheduled for Tuesday, May 25, 2021. No action was taken.

448 EAST LANE: The City Council reviewed the nuisance complaints with City Attorney Justin Deppe. The City Council asked City Attorney Deppe and Police Chief Turpen to proceed with the nuisance abatement process.

CITY WIDE CLEAN UP DAY RESULTS: There were 26 loads of trash, furniture, tires and appliances removed from the City of Jewell on Saturday, May 15, 2021. The City of Jewell collected \$620.00 which will be used to pay a portion of the dumpster and landfill fees.
